**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE JUBILEE PARK MEETING ROOM
AT 7.30PM ON 28 April 2016.**

Present:- Cllrs Lowings (Chairman), Harvey, Goldsmith and Crummett

In attendance: Mrs K Wilson (Clerk) and 34 members of the public

To receive and accept apologies for absence from Cllrs Bennett, Myhill and Dimoglu

- To receive disclosure of personal and prejudicial interest and disclosable pecuniary interest and requests for dispensations from Councillors on matters to be considered at the meeting.

No disclosures were made.

- 2 To hold a public session.

There were 34 members of the public in attendance and numerous members spoke about their concerns regarding the possible LSC status of the village.

3. Members of the public also requested an investigation into what they perceived to be a non disclosure situation by Cllr Dimoglu and asked for this to be included on the next agenda.

The chairman closed the public session at 8.00pm.

- 4 LSC Status. It was decided that the case for the reversal on the previous decision regarding LSC status was strong in that it did not comply with the recognised conditions due to the lack of local facilities. i.e. there is no shop, no post office or public house. The only relevant business is Yaxham Waters, which had been put forward as potentially one of four Additional Emerging Sites Land Allocation Options development land thereby negating its relevance to the LSC status. This situation only came to light after the Council meeting held on 11th February 2016. A vote was taken and the decision to reverse the previous vote was unanimous.

- 5 It was agreed that Yaxham Parish Council would send a letter to Breckland confirming they wished to reverse the previous decision on LSC status in the light of new information and further consideration.
