

Meeting of Yaxham Parish Charity Held in the Jubilee Hall Meeting Room at 7.00PM on 28th June 2018.

Present Cllrs. Lowings (Chairman), Crummett, Harvey, Goldsmith & Martin. **In Attendance** 33 residents & Mrs M Eversfield (Clerk).

- 1. Chairman's opening remarks. The Chairman welcomed all those present.
- **2. To receive apologies for absence**. Apologies had not been received from Cllrs Bennett and Dimoglou at this point in time.
- 3. To receive disclosures of personal & prejudicial interests. None.
- **4.** To agree and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 26th April 2018. These were unanimously agreed and signed by the Chairman.
- 5. Public discussion on charity matters. A resident that had been assisting the Parish Charity and Parish Council with regard to a new village sign to commemorate WW1 questioned what had happened to the current sign. It was noted that Cllr Crummett was renovating is as part of his biannual gift to the Parish and that the residents work with regard to a new sign is not a wasted effort. The resident also spoke about a possible roll of honour to commemorate those who died in action.

- 7. To consider any related grant applications or ideas for the village to mark the WW1 100th Anniversary (11th November 2018). Various ideas were discussed including a roll of honour, a new village sign, a memorial bench to be placed in the Churchyard and a civic event at the Village Hall.
