    - 7.1.1 To agree an initial budget of £500 for Yaxham Cares to cover costs (including those already incurred)
       A breakdown was supplied to Cllrs detailing the printing costs of the A5 leaflet which totalled £34.22 less printers rebate of £5.63 = Total of £28.59.

Lanyards and badge making to identify volunteers = £60.73 plus £6.43 VAT. The suggested budget of £500 was unanimously AGREED. The Net budget remaining of £439.27 was NOTED.
