

MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF YAXHAM PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 25TH AUGUST 2022 AT 7.00PM IN THE DAVID MYHILL ROOM AT YAXHAM VILLAGE HALL

Present: Cllrs Maggie Oechsle (MO) (Chairman), Richard Whadcoat (RW) (Vice Chairman), Chris Couves (CC), and Bob Gust (BG)

In attendance: Clerk and one member of the public.

1. Chairman's Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed everyone and informed everyone that the meeting was being recorded.

2. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Peter Lowings and Ben Conway. All approved this.

3. Declarations of interest

There were no declarations of interest

4. Public Session

There were no matters raised.

5. Play Area Working Group Report

The Chairman recapped the situation and explained she had spoken to Justin Coote from Badger and he explained that the agreement is being dealt with by the solicitors at present and he did not see any reason why the agreement will not be signed and monies then deposited with Breckland Council.

The Councillors discussed the risks involved. It was proposed that a 30-day extension and revalidation of the quote would be asked for along with a 25% deposit.

CC proposed, RW seconded and all agreed.

The Chairman will wait a week for a response from Breckland Council before she contacts them again.

6. Local Plan Review

The Chairman reported there was to be an informal meeting in the second half of September of the Chairmen & Vice Chairmen representing most of the parish councils in the Mattishall Ward plus others to discuss the Local Plan progress and other issues.

The Chairman would report back at the next Yaxham Parish Council meeting. The matter would therefore be deferred until then.

The Clerk asked if the Councillors agreed with the location of the Well Hill bus stop and bench which had been circulated prior to the meeting. All agreed.
